Viewing Chat Recordings – D2L Student Tutorial


This tutorial is designed for students who would like to use the Chat tool for online text-based discussions or group work with fellow students. Note that you may need to ask your instructor to set up the Chat tool on your D2L course Navbar. For further information or assistance, go to our Team Dynamix Support portal and click the appropriate Category to submit a ticket.

Scenario

This tutorial will cover the steps involved in viewing the text recordings of **Chat** sessions in your course. You will be able to view chat session recordings for any Chatroom you have created or have been given access to by others.

Steps

1. In your D2L course, click the Chat link (in the Nav Bar or under the MyTools menu.)








2. Click the down arrow next to the title of the **Chat** for which you wish to view the session recordings and select **View Sessions**.




3. You will see a list of the individual session recordings, with the **Start Dates** (linked to the session recording for that session), the **End Dates**, the **Duration** of the session, and the **# of Messages** in the recording. Click the link for the specific session you wish to view the recording.





4. You can view the text recording in the **Chat Text** section. Click **Print** at the top right to download or print the Chat Session recording. Click **Done** to return to the Chat Session table.



5. Click **Done** to return to the main **Chat** area.
