



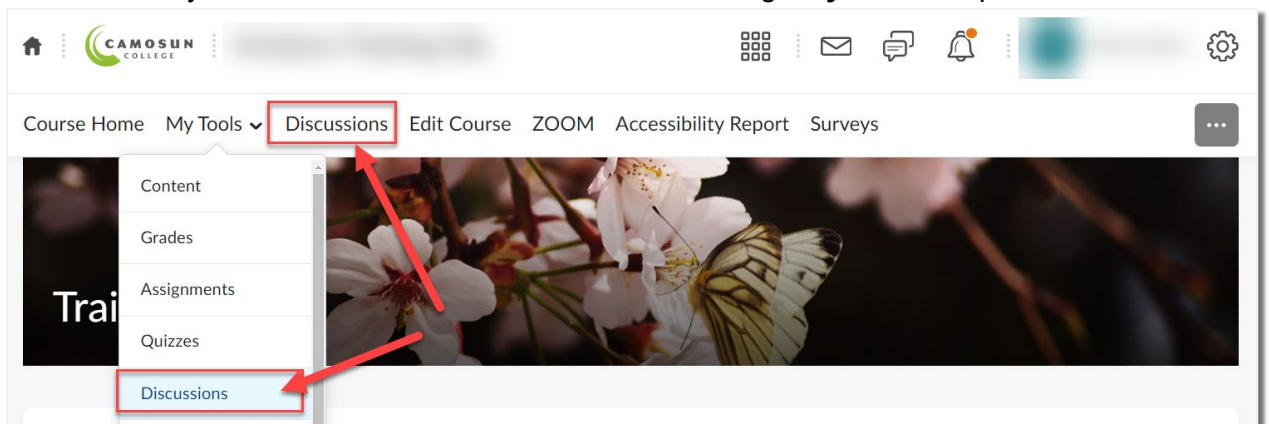
Viewing Discussion Feedback via Discussions Tool – D2L Tutorial

This tutorial describes how to view feedback on discussion posts via the Discussions Tool in D2L.

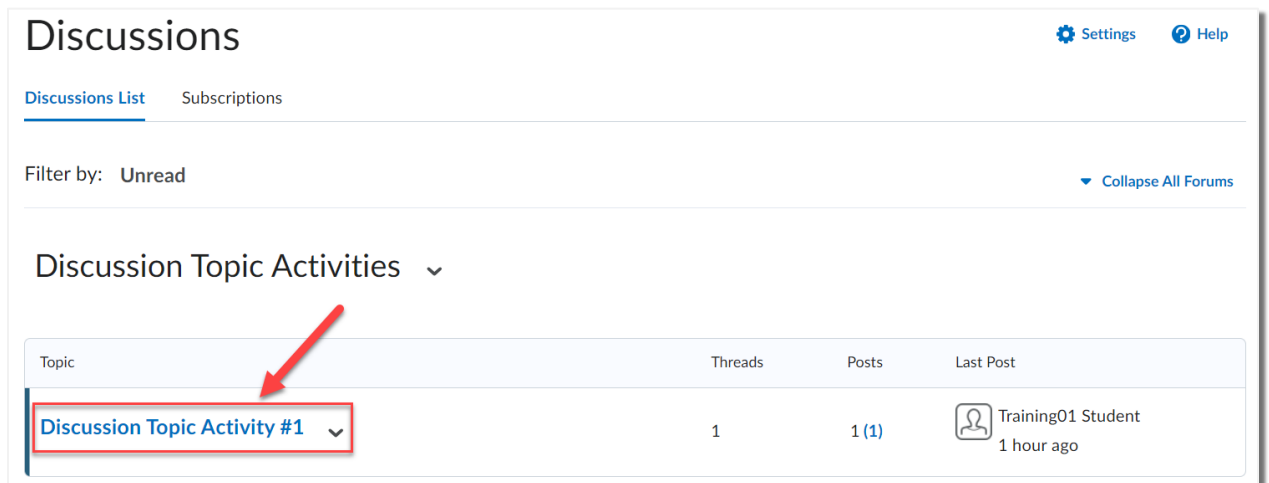

Steps


1. Navigate to your course in D2L.
2. Click **Discussions** in the course navigation bar.
Note: You may need to access the Discussions Tool through **My Tools** drop-down menu



3. From the Discussions page, click on the discussion topic you want to review feedback for.



4. Review your feedback in the **Feedback** section located below the discussion description/instructions. If your instructor used a rubric to assess your post, click the **View Graded Rubric** link to open the rubric in a pop-up window.
