



## Adding Widgets to your Homepage – D2L Tutorial

### Scenario

This tutorial will cover the steps involved when you wish to add Widgets from your Widgets list onto your course's Homepage.


### Steps

1. Go to your course homepage and click **Edit Course**.



2. Click **Homepages**.




3. Click on the title of your active Homepage.




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4. Scroll down, then click on the **Add Widgets** button in the section of the Homepage you wish to add a Widget to.



5. In the pop-up box, select the Widget(s) you want to add to your Homepage (to see only widgets you have created, click **Custom Widget**). Click **Add**.



6. If you like, you can move your new Widget by clicking and holding down your left mouse button on the Widget, and dragging it to another location in the Widget box. Click **Save and Close**.
