

Adding a Kaltura Video to a Discussion in D2L – A Student Kaltura Tutorial

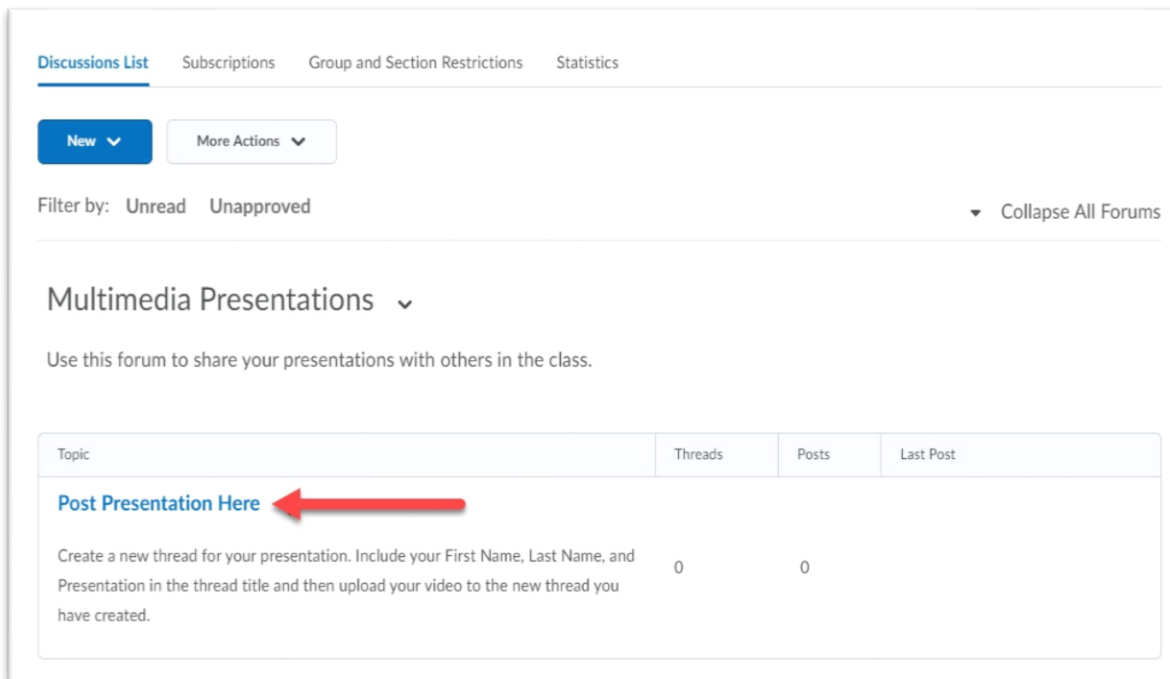
Kaltura is the streaming media tool integrated into D2L and supported by eLearning at Camosun. Kaltura gives faculty and students a place to upload, create, and edit their course-related videos, audio files, and images. . For further information, please contact elearning@camosun.ca for assistance.

Scenario

This tutorial will cover the steps involved when you wish to embed a video (*that you have already uploaded into your **My Media** space*) into the Discussions tool in D2L.

Steps

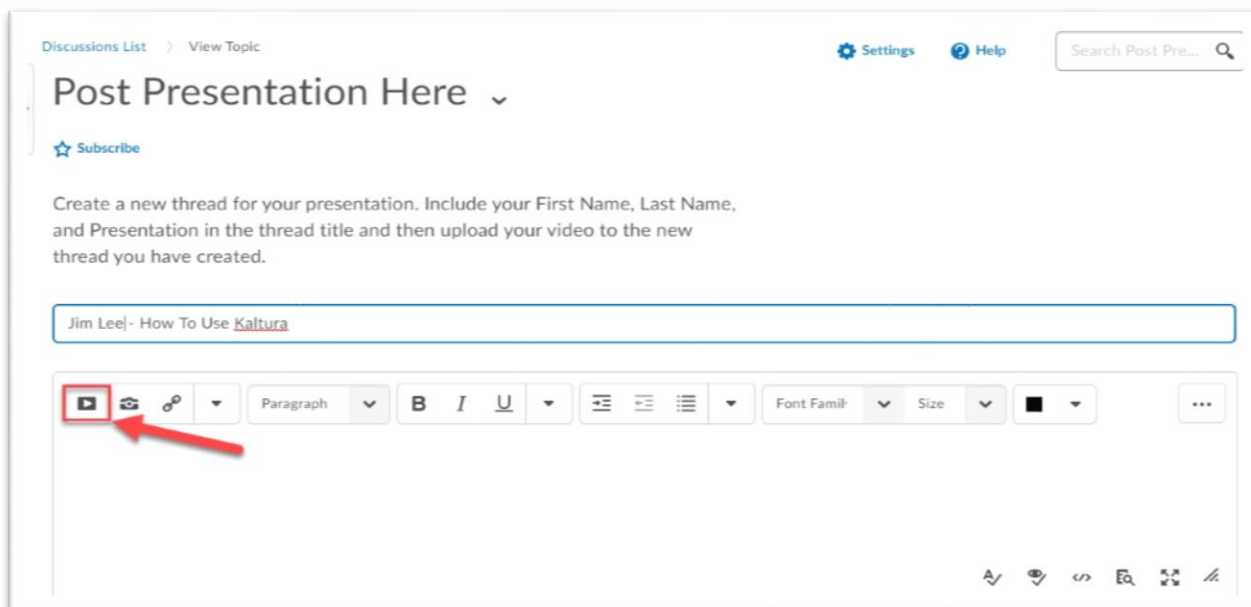
1. Go to your D2L course, and then to the **Discussions** tool.
2. Click on the title of the **Discussion Topic** you want to add your video to.



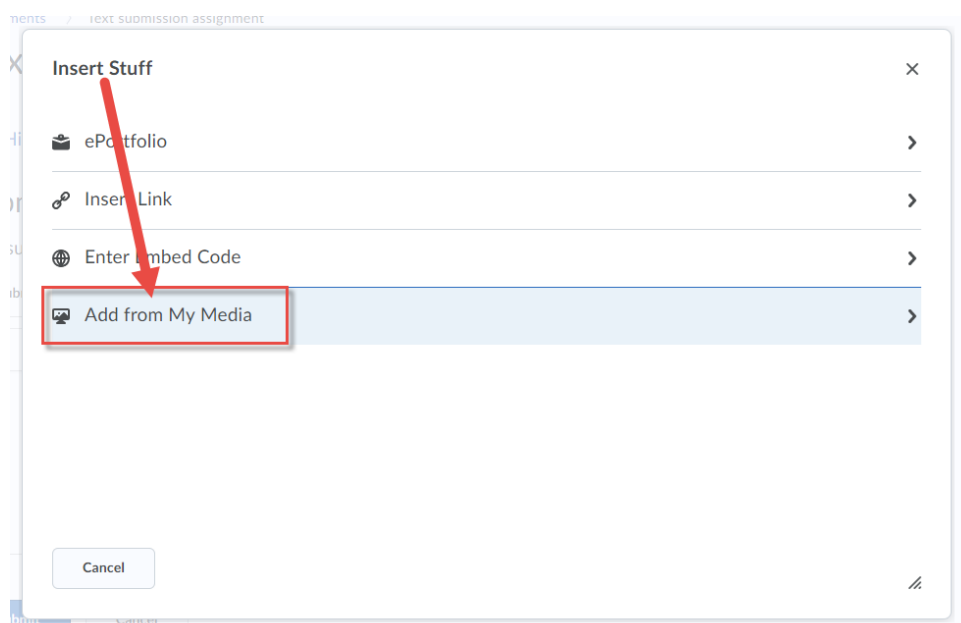

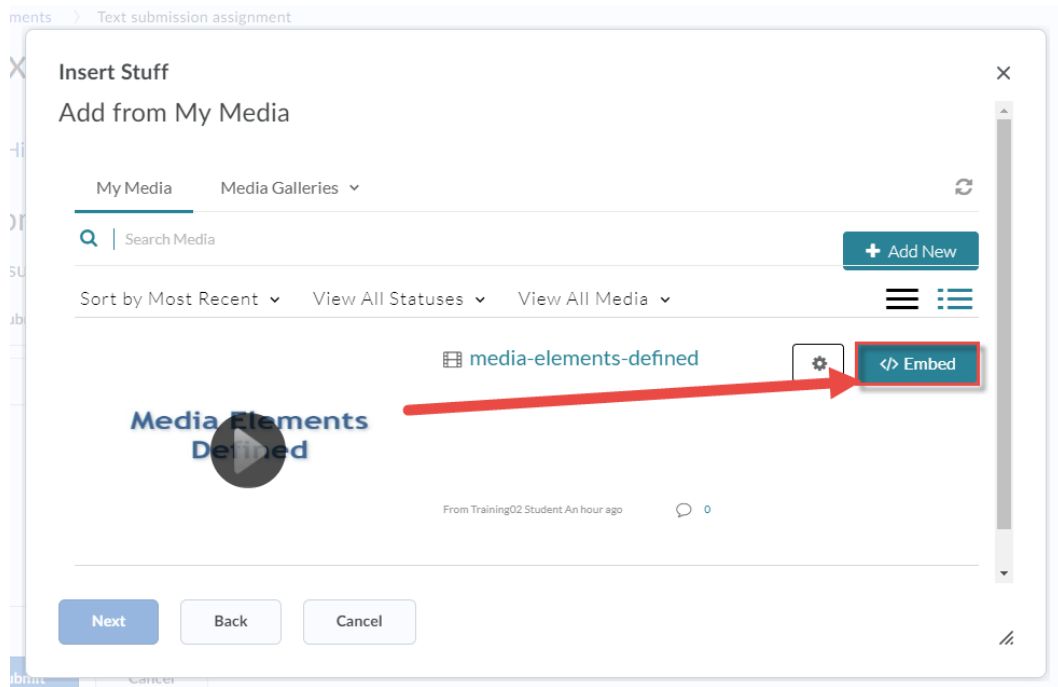
3. Click **Start a New Thread** (or reply to an existing thread), add a **Subject**, then click the **Insert Stuff** icon (at the top, left on the toolbar.)



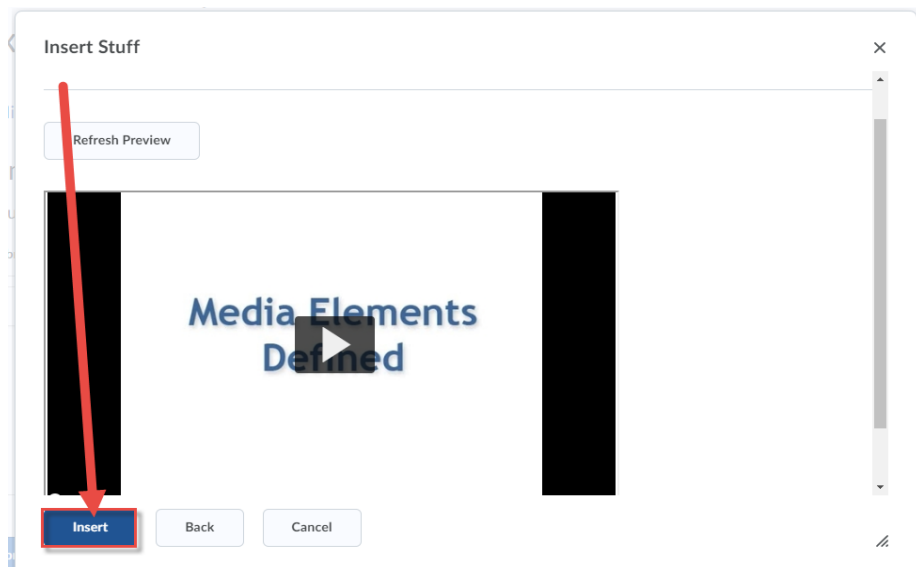
4. In the **Insert Stuff** box that opens, click **Add from My Media**.



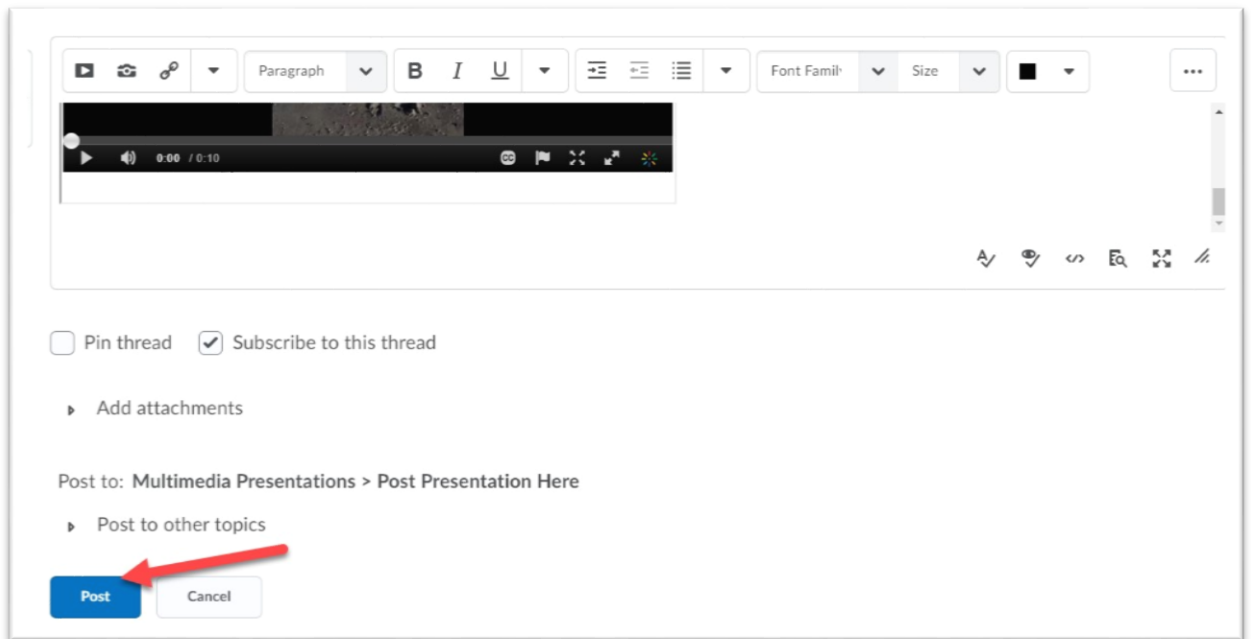
5. Scroll down to find your video assignment, and click the **Embed** button.



6. Make sure the video appearing in the **Preview** window is the right one, then click **Insert**.



7. Click **Post**.
