

Changing a Student's Gradebook View in Settings – D2L Tutorial

Scenario

This tutorial will cover the steps involved when you want to customize grade details and basic display options for your students' gradebooks.

Steps

- 1. Go to the Grades tool in your course.
- 2. From either the Manage Grades or Enter Grades, click on the Settings link (at the top, right).

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3. Click on the Org Unit Display Options tab.

4. Make changes to the **Student View Display Options** as needed. You can test your settings by saving them and previewing a student's gradebook, and going back to **Settings** to make further changes until you are satisfied with the view. Click **Save** to save your selections.

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5. You can also click the Calculation Options tab to make one further change. Scroll down to find Grade Calculations where you can choose either Drop ungraded items (meaning students will not see anything for items not yet graded, but meaning you will have to enter zeros for those students who do not complete those items) or Treat ungraded items as 0 (meaning students will see zeros for all ungraded items in their gradebook). Click Save to save your changes. Click Close to return to the Grades tool.

Things to Remember
