

## Making a Copy of a Kaltura Video in D2L – Kaltura Tutorial



### Scenario


This tutorial will cover the steps involved when you wish to make a copy of a video in Kaltura, for example so that you can edit the copy while keeping the original intact.

### Steps


1. Go to your course in D2L.
2. Go to **My Media**.



3. Click the title of the video you want to copy.




4. Scroll down, click **Actions** and select **Launch Editor**.


5. If a Warning pops up, click **OK**. Click **Save a Copy**.



6. Give your copy a title and click **Create**.



7. Click **Go to Media** Page to go to the copy, **Go to My Media** to return to Kaltura My Media, or **OK** to return to the Video Editor (which contains the original video).



## Things to Remember

Once you have created a copy, you can open that copy and launch the Video Editor to make minor edits (clipping, trimming, etc.) to the copy. See the tutorial *Editing a Kaltura Video in D2L* for more information.
