

## Uploading to My Media using an Apple Mobile Device – A Student Kaltura Tutorial

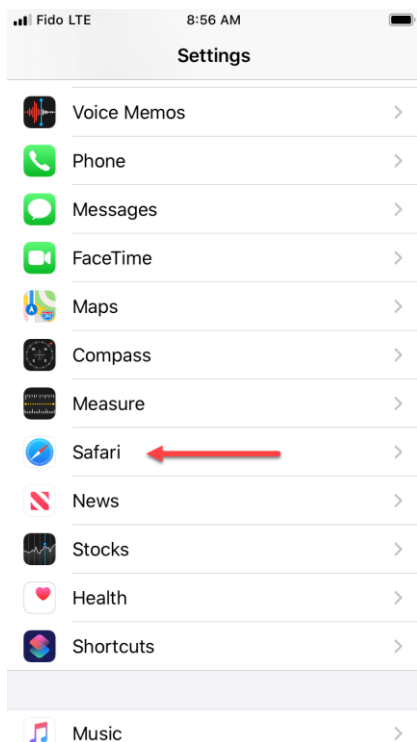
**Kaltura** is a new streaming media tool recently adopted by Camosun. Integrated into D2L, and supported by eLearning, Kaltura gives faculty and students a place to upload, create, and edit their course-related videos, audio files, and images. ### Scenario

This tutorial will cover the steps involved when you wish to use upload media to your **My Media** space using an iPhone or iPad. Note that you will need to use Safari to log into D2L in order to upload media to **My Media**.

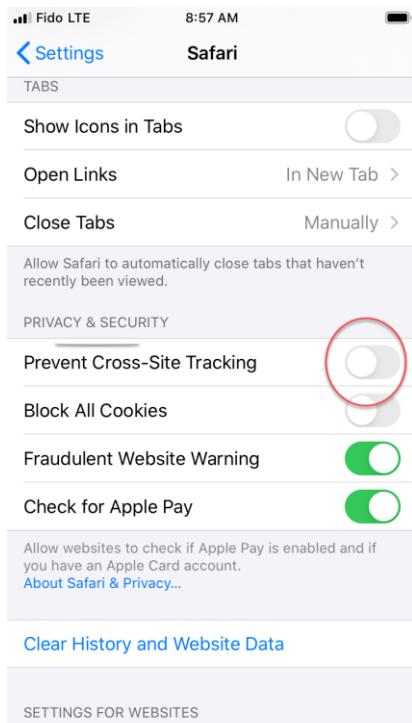
### Steps

1. Click on the **Settings** icon on your iPhone or iPad.
2. Find the **Safari** icon, and click on it.

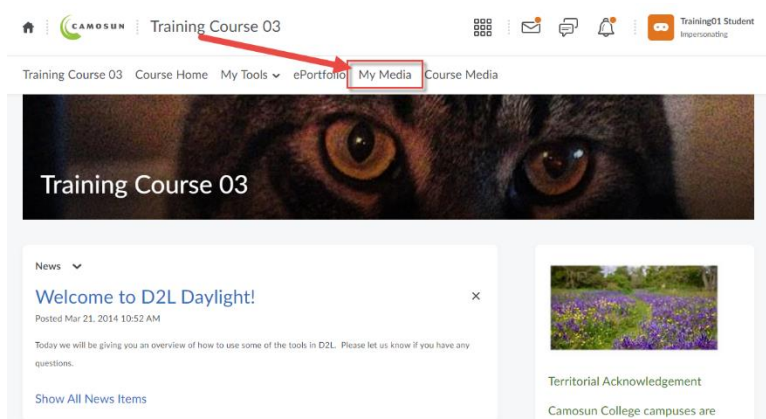

3. Locate the **Privacy & Security** settings, and turn off **Prevent Cross-Site Tracking**.



4. Open **Safari** on your device. Note, in order to upload media to **My Media** you MUST use Safari.
5. Go to Camosun.ca, click D2L, then click on your course title.
6. Go to **My Media** (it may be a link on the NavBar or in the **My Tools** drop-down menu) to open your personal Kaltura space. Follow the steps in the *Uploading Media (Video) to My Media in D2L* tutorial.



## Things to Remember

If Safari gives you an error message, you may need to update your iOS.
